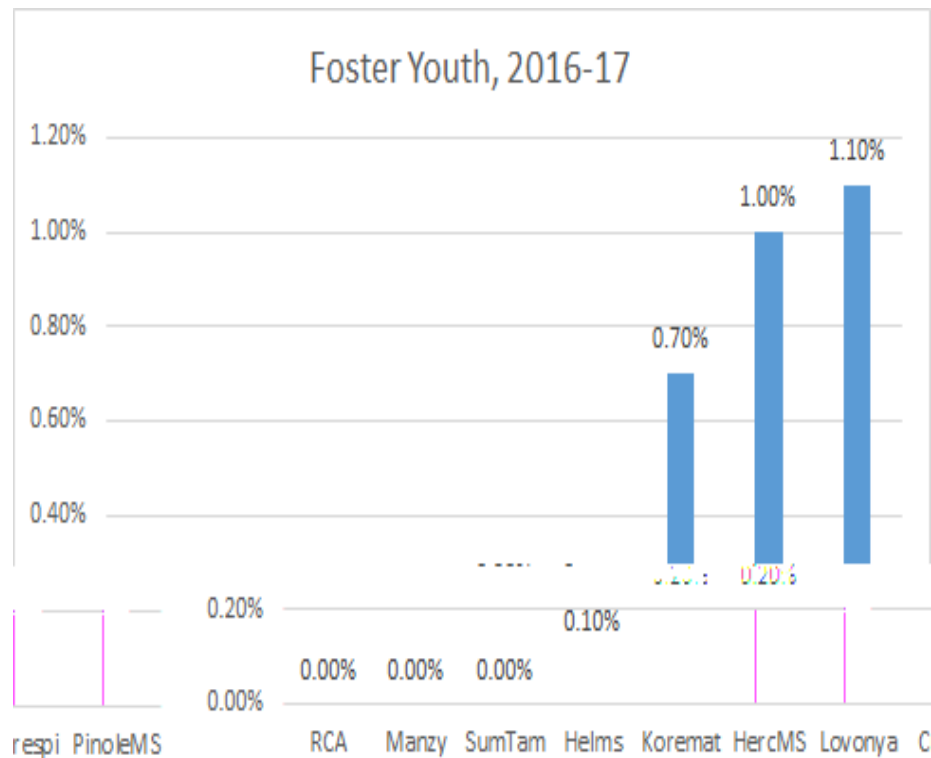

Schools included are: Crespi, DeJean, Helms, Hercules MS, Korematsu, Manzanita, Pinole MS,

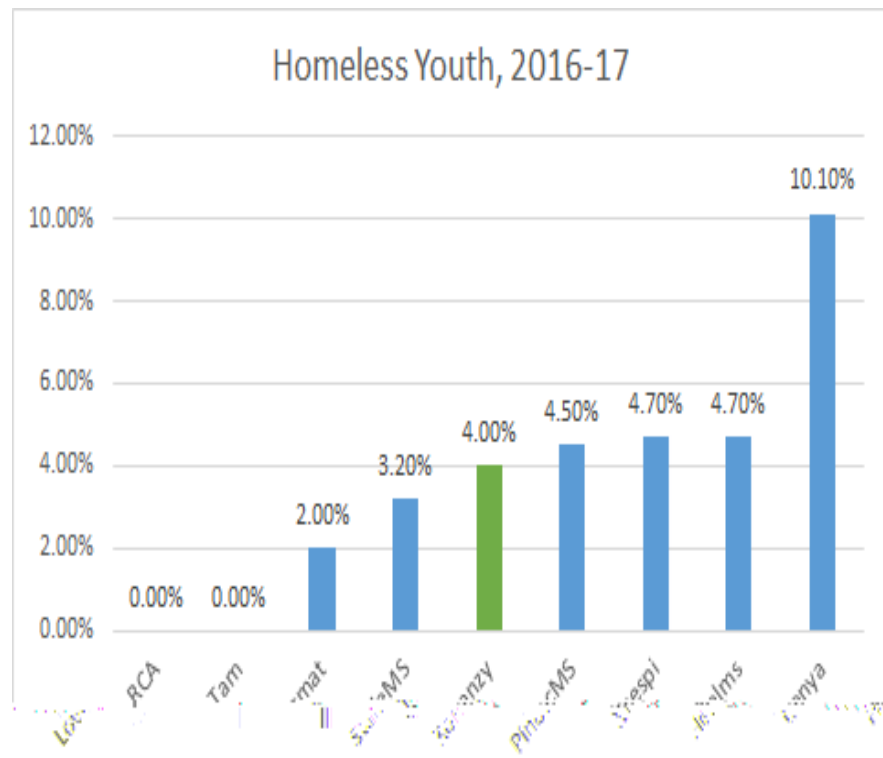

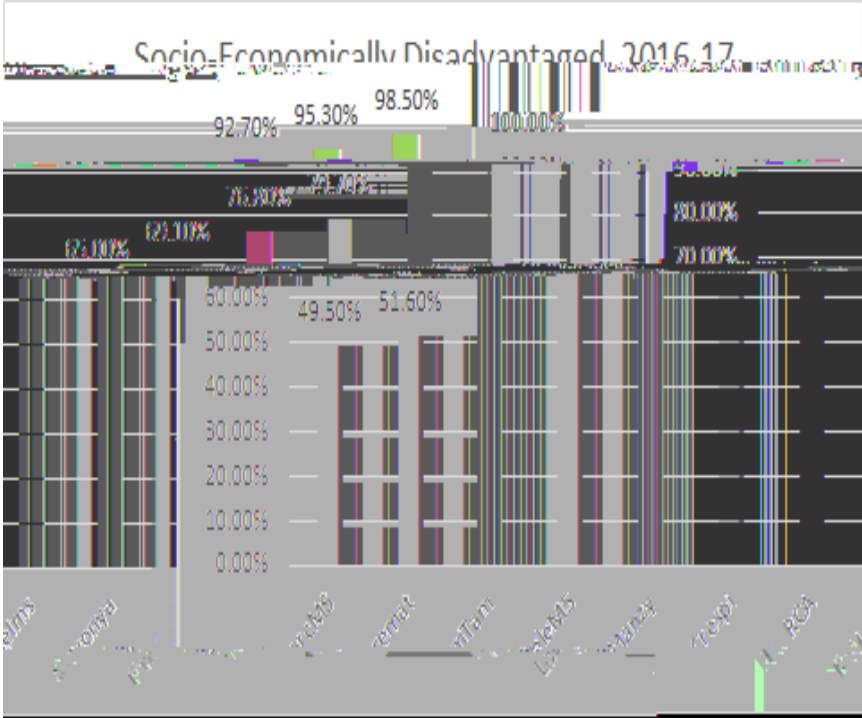
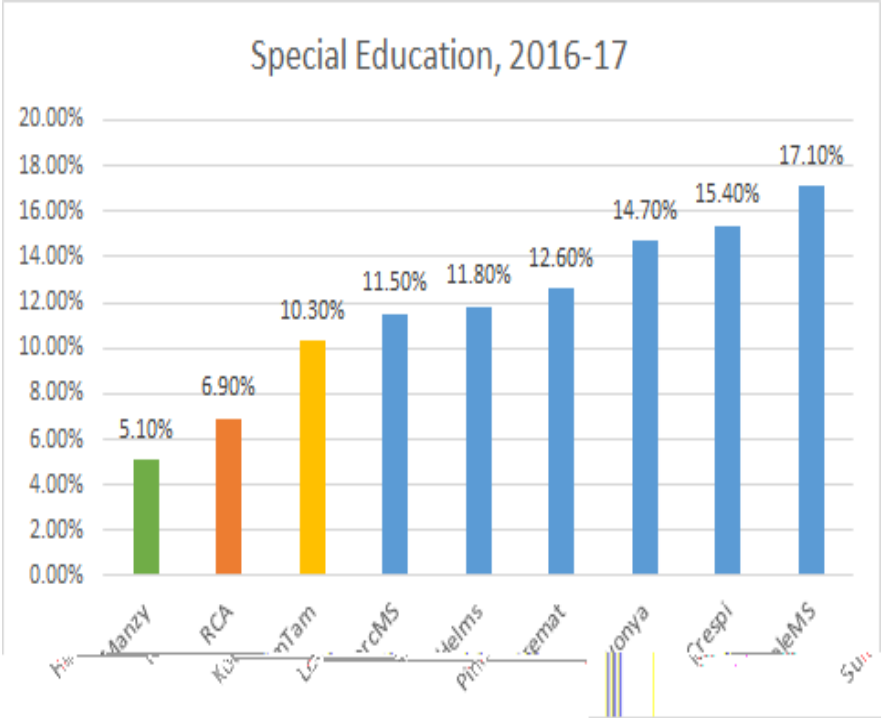
Foster Youth, 2016-17



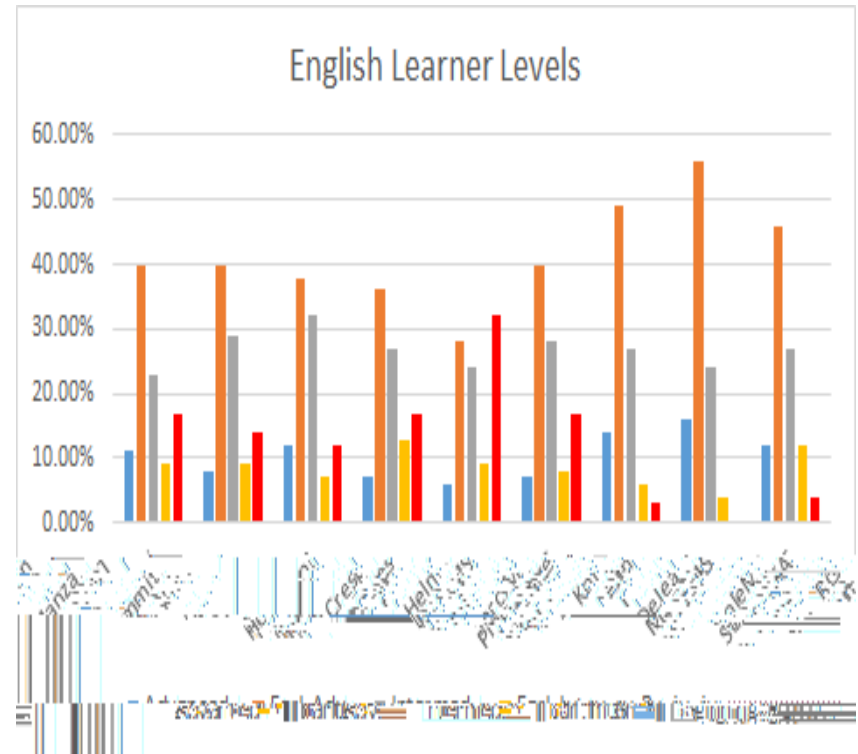
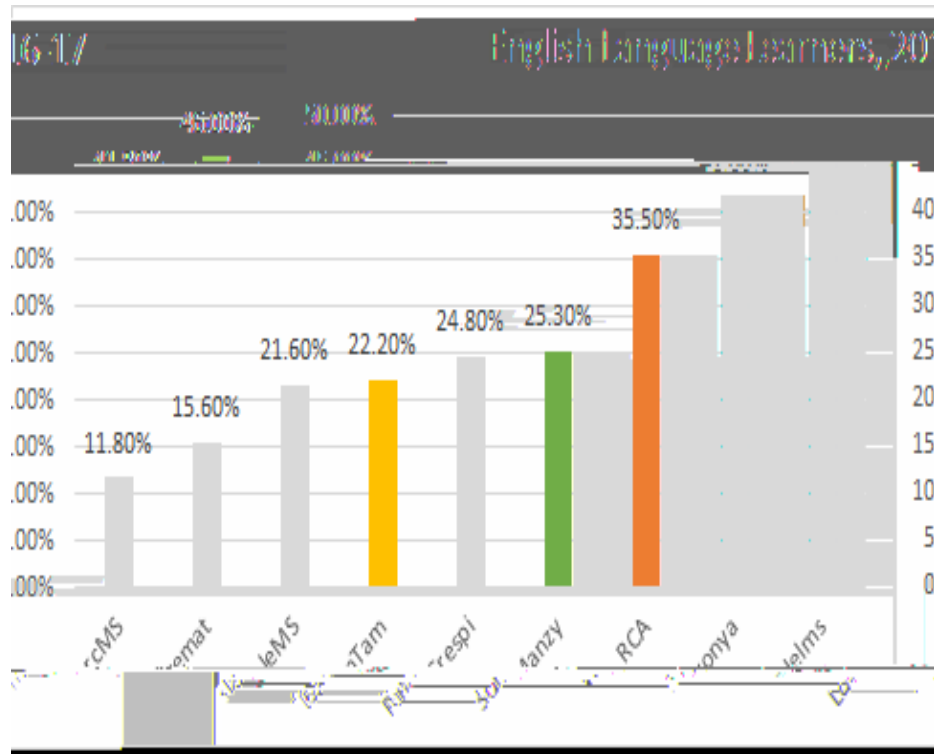
Homeless Youth, 2016-17



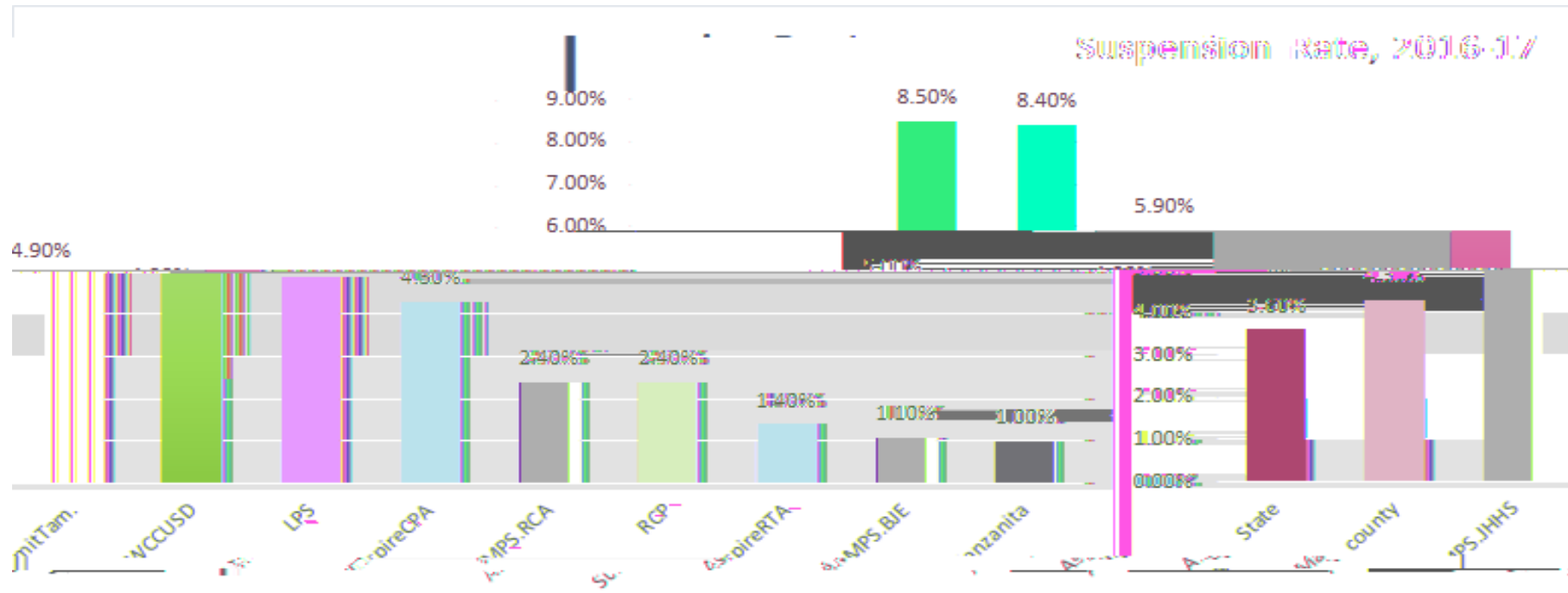

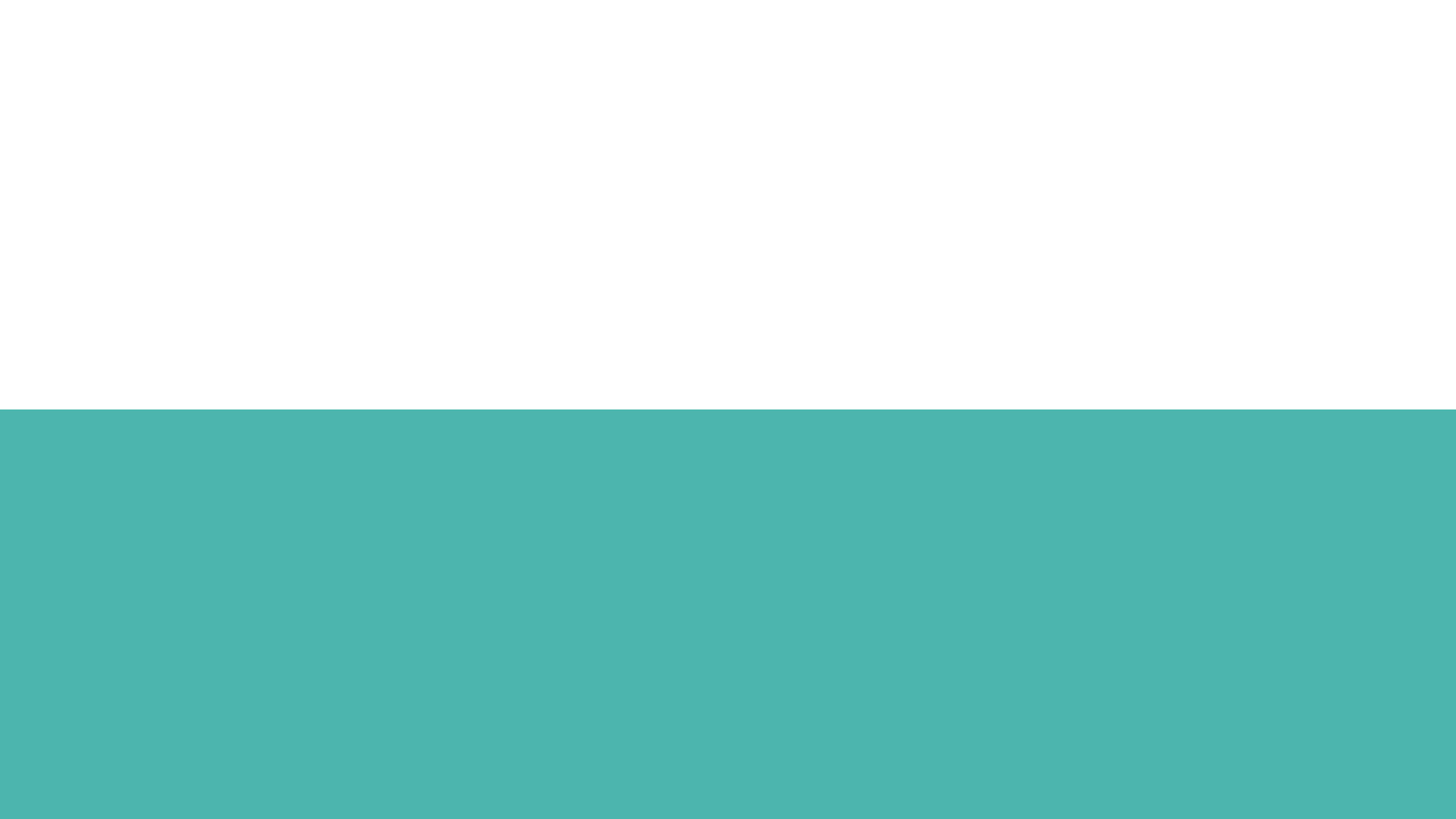


English Language Learner Percentages and Levels



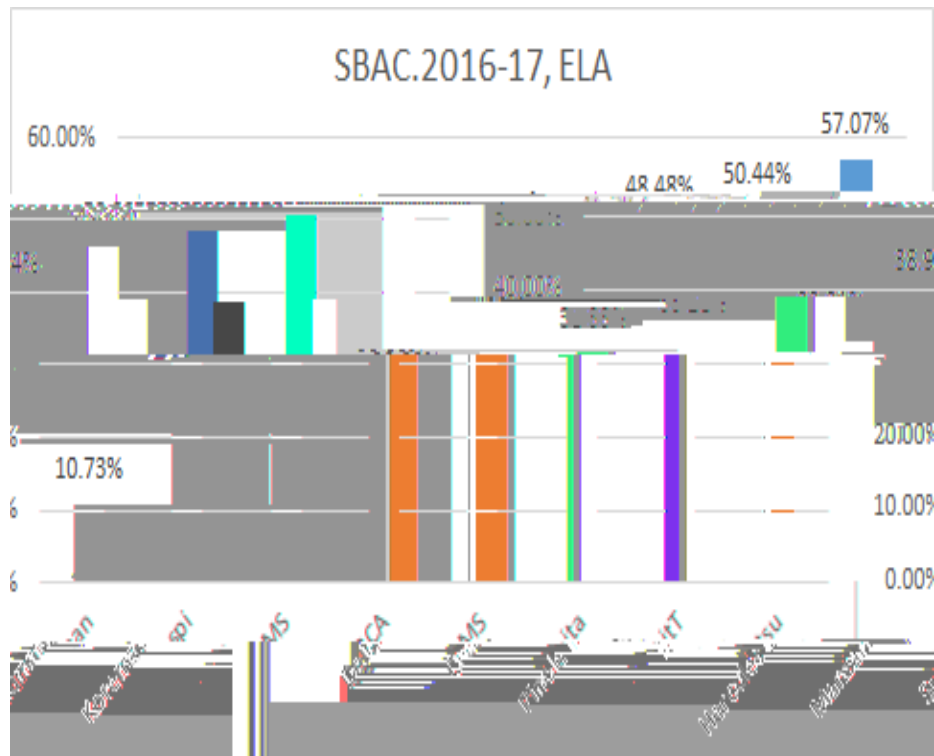
Suspension Rates
