## Phasing out Transitional Bilingual Education Immersion (DLI) programming - Dr. Gracie Guer

More elements of the TBE will be phased out at implementation of On-Way DLI for bilingual students. There has been significant communication with leaders, teachers, community members and UTR to make this transition as smooth as possible. Because of the nature of the K-3 grade levels, the implementation is already taking place in Spanish. As a result, it is anticipated that minimal staffing changes will need to be made. This phase will continue in the 2020-2021 year with 4th grade, and additional bilingual-certified teachers will need to be hired at participating campuses. A final list of bilingual campuses and participating grade levels will be published in April.
