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Dear Parent or Guardian:

To make sure your child is ready for school California law, Education **Sedte**on 49452.8, now requires that your child have an oral health assessment (dentalup) exykMay 3[†] in either kindergarten or first grade, whichever is his or her first year in public school. Assessments that have happened within the 12 months before your child enters school also meet this requirement. The law specifies that the assessment must be done by a licensed dentist or other licensed or registered dental health professional.

Take the attached Oral Health Assessment/Waiver Request form to the dental office, as it will be needed for your child's check-up. If you cannot take your child for this required assessment, please indicate the reason for this in Section 3 of the form. You can get more copies of the necessary form at your child's school or online from the California Department of Education's website at http://www.cde.ca.gov/ls/he/hn/.
